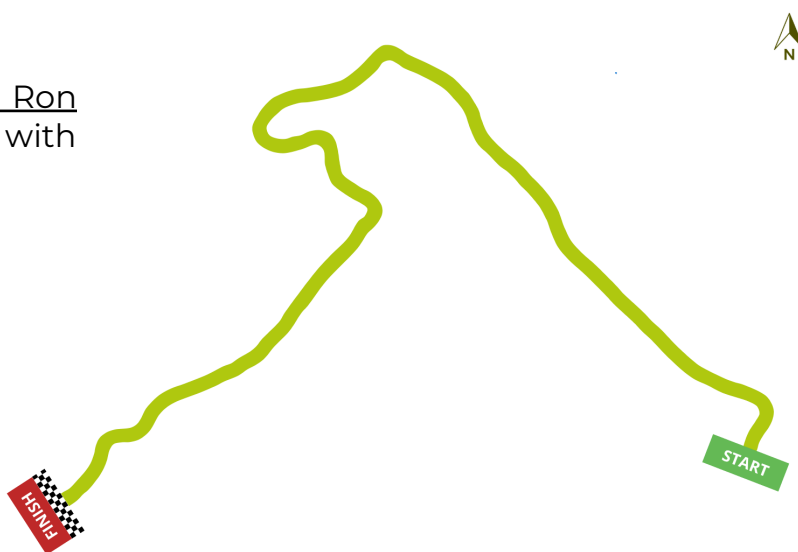
Dear National Federation,

We are pleased to provide the first ever Downhill Skateboarding Challenger event Bulletin#01, to be held from 13th to 15th of November, in Songkhla region, Thailand. The organizing committee will host an additional practice day (*Freeride*) on November 12th for those who wish to spend more time on the hill prior to the competition.

VENUE

The event will take place in Kuan Ron Hill, 1h20min away from Songkhla, with an approximate altitude of 210m.

Length	1,6km
Steepness	8% average 10% maximum



PROVISIONAL SCHEDULE

November 12th - *Freeride*, Technical meeting

November 13th - Official practice, Technical meeting

November 14th - Time Trials

November 15th - Race

Please note that it may be subject to change once the registration has closed.

COMPETITION FORMAT

The competition will be held for Downhill Skateboarding only.

The competition will be structured as follows:

- Time Trials (Men and Women): 2 runs, the best run counts. Time Trials will serve as qualification and seeding for the Racing.
- Racing (4-person heats for both men and women).

REGISTRATION & COUNTRY QUOTA

Registrations are handled exclusively by the Local Organising Committee (LOC). The registration window will open from September 1st to October 31st and will be accessible through a Google Forms link published by the LOC on their social media platforms:

Athletes must create an Infinity profile ([HERE](#)) in order to be validated in the official World Skate Challenger results. Infinity is World Skate's sports platform which is used to verify athlete information and eligibility to compete. This profile must include an up-to-date anti-doping certificate and a valid passport. Any athletes without a complete Infinity profile including a valid anti-doping certificate and passport will be allowed to participate but will not receive World Ranking points. Entry fee:

Each competing athlete in Downhill Skateboarding will pay a net fee of 150 USD.

The fee includes full board during event days (3 meals/day) and breakfast on November 16th.

There is no limitation on the country quota. The registration will be open.

Note:

For non competition registration (*Freeride*), please refer to the LOC contact link provided above.

Registered athletes in Street Luge and Inline will have a registration option at a discounted price and will be allowed to skate on a *Freeride* mode all days except on November 14th - Time Trials.

OFFICIAL HOTEL

The official hotel for the event will be the [BP Samila Beach Hotel](#) (Songkhla).

Included services:

- Shuttle from Hat Yai Airport (HDY) to the official Hotel on November 11th at 16:00 (local time) and from the official hotel to Hat Yai Airport (HDY) on November 16th at 12:00h (local time).
- Shuttle to the venue and back everyday.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the WADA Code, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), incorporating the requirements of the Technical Document for Sport Specific Analysis (TDSSA), and following the instruction of the World Skate Anti-doping Delegate.

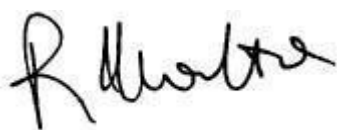
During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Organizations and/or World Skate during 2024, 2025 and 2026 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the [WADA ADEL platform](#) and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the [WADA ADEL platform](#) is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.
