### WORLD SKATE INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR – ARTISTIC SKATING

The World Skate International Seminar will be held in Rome (Italy) from 17<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> January 2018 and it is intended for those judges that want to become Specialists. The course will be focused mainly on the new RollArt scoring system, with in-depth analysis on the following modalities:

- Free (Single)
- Pairs
- Dance
- Precision

The modalities above will employ the new scoring system starting from 2019.

Knowing the importance of this occasion and of the topics that will be addressed, World Skate has decided to open the seminar also to the coaches of all levels that **will attend the Specialist course together with the judges** in order to allow a correct dissemination of such an important matter.

Coaches will also take classes given by teachers and external consultants about subjects relating to roller skating, choreography, dance, etc.

World Skate will award a participation certificate to all the participants.

All those whom the Federations will propose as future WORLD SKATE Coaches, registering to the Seminar will have to submit the curriculum in attachment duly filled out.

At the end of the course, the final exam will be taken only by those who want to become Specialists and not by the coaches.


