INLINE HOCKEY REGISTRATION PROCESS USER GUIDE


This guide provides all the necessary information to ensure a successful registration process to the World Skate Inline Hockey 2018 World Championships, which will be held in Asiago and Roana (Italy) from July 14th to July 28th 2018.

The aim of this guide is to provide all the authorized users accessing the Sports Entry Platform with an overview on all the available functions and operational instructions.

The Platform is a web-based system, which requires the users to log in using the access information already in possession of all the National Federations.


Let's start from the beginning!








Once you logged into the Platform, you need to select the *Events* section as shown below






Once you get in the selected event page, you will find a list of the disciplines provided for in the relevant event











And this is the staff one



Please note that if you have already applied for a Staff Member role, this will be no longer available for the Team concerned. In the same way note that once a person registered as Staff Member (for example a *Doctor*), you will not be able to register him/her again but he/she will be registered as Staff Member for the National Federation, no what matter he/she category was initially registered.



Start the Registration process by clicking on *New* or, in case you have already registered a participant in the past, select him/her in the record list below






In case of a *New record*, a registration form will show up. Please follow the steps.

STEP 2 You will be asked to tick the Privacy checkbox.

This last request is very important to us and we strongly recommend you to read and fully understand the accessible Policy and its Terms of Use before giving your consent.



STEP 1

We kindly ask you to fill in all the fields included in the form or, at least the ones marked with the *.

You will be also asked to upload three different files:

- A .jpeg picture (headshot) for the Accreditation card
- A .pdf or .jpeg file of your Passport
- A .pdf file of the Anti-Doping Acknowledgement and Agreement form duly signed (Athletes only).

Said files shall be named with the Passport number (i.e. BB3214.jpeg).

Regarding the headshot, even though Mr. Goya's portrait is stunning, we kindly ask you to follow the instructions provided for in the attached picture guidelines.



In case you need to select a participant who was already registered, select him/her from the list which you can find on the bottom of the page






You are currently allowed to register at least 8 and up to 25 players for each team. Before the end of the Registration Process you will receive a notice from World Skate which will ask you to reduce the number of players to 16 (2 goalkeepers and 14 floor players).

In case you will not fulfil this duty within July 3rd (Registration Process expiration term), the Inline Hockey Technical Commission will <u>arbitrarily</u> proceed to reduce the number of players to 16 with no right to appeal.

Once you have finished to register Athletes and Staff Members, you need to click the <u>Save</u> button. In this way you will save all of your records, which you may change again and again until the end of the registration Process.

Please note that if you do not press the <u>Save</u> button and try to carry out another activity, you will lose all the records which have not been saved.







NOTA BENE:

All the sports records for both Athletes and Staff Members, such as the choice of the specialities, the number of participants for each speciality etc., must be in compliance with the limits set out in the World Skate Inline Hockey Technical Regulations.

The System will check everything during the saving process and, every time it notices errors, mistakes or in case of a misuse of the Platform (i.e. limits exceeding, documents missing etc.), the System will automatically generate a red flag notice which will inform you about the kind of error that occurred and what needs to be done in order to solve the problem.

PHOTO GUIDELINES:

- I. Digital ID Photos
- (I) Photo-taking requirements
- 1. The photo must be a colored digital photo of a full-face bareheaded head portrait of the applicant taken within six months.
- 2. The background of the photo must be in light color, such as white or light blue, and the clothing color must be different from the color of the background.
- 3. Do not wear hats or scarves on head (except those worn for religious reasons, but the eyebrows, eyes, nose, mouth, face, and ears must be exposed clearly). The neck must be exposed clearly without wearing any scarf.
- 4. Look straight ahead with a natural expression when having the photo taken.
- 5. Do not wear sunglasses (unless you are a blind person), lens less glasses, or glasses with dark lenses through which the eyes cannot be been.
- (II) Specification requirements
- 1. The aspect ratio of the photo is 2:3 with the width no less than 32 mm and the height no less than 48 mm. Example:

2. The photo must be in 24-bit RGB true color with a resolution of 300 DPI or above. There must be a blank margin between the top of the head and the edge of the photo.
