TECHNICAL SPECIALISTS: INTERNATIONAL EXAMS

Each National Federation is able to nominate a maximum of two entries for each discipline for the test of Technical Specialist.

"International Technical Specialist" for Free Skating, Pairs, Dance and Precision. The exam fee is 100 USD or 90 EUR.

Please note that for the Technical Specialist exams, only international judges may apply.

The test will be ruled as follows:

- Written part. There will be 29 multiple choice questions. From the 4 choices, one, two, three or all the four answers can be correct. To pass to the practical test, 80% of the answers must be correct. If the judge is already specialist in one of the disciplines, the questions will be 25, excluding code of ethics questions.

Questions will be based on the documents: "World Skate 2020 Rule books" (of the discipline/s chosen) and "World Skate General 2020".

- Practical part. The applicant will be asked to watch 2 videos and call the elements as if he/she was in a real panel. Even if the written part is good, if the judge fails the practical part he/she will not pass the test.

IMPORTANT:

The same international judge can apply for a maximum of two (2) disciplines.

For dance, the questions will be related to the pattern dances chosen for the 2020 Junior and Senior Style Dances.

Written Part

- Unanswered questions will be counted as not correct.
- Some of the questions may require a free text answer.
- It is allowed 1 hour maximum for the written test.
- For those that apply to do two disciplines, there will be 25 questions more (technical on the second discipline) and it will be allowed a total of 1:45 hours.

Practical Part

- The examinees must demonstrate sureness in the calling of the elements.



- For at least one of the two (2) videos the examinees must not do any mistake.
- For the other video maximum two (2) call errors will be accepted.

JUDGES: INTERNATIONAL EXAMS

"International Judge" for Free Skating and figures, Pairs, Dance, Precision and Show. The exam fee is 70 USD or 60 EUR.

We remind you that each National Federation is able to nominate a maximum of two entries for each discipline for the test of International Judge.

To get the title of **World Skate International Judge**, for the World Skate competitions in the chosen discipline/s, the test will be ruled as follows:

- Written part. There will be 25 multiple choice questions. Between the 4 choices, one, two, three or all the four answers can be correct. To get to the practical test, 80% of the answers must be correct. If the judge is already an international judge on one of the disciplines, there will only be 20 questions (excluding artistic impression questions).

Questions will be based on the documents: "World Skate 2020 Rulebooks" (of the discipline/s chosen), "World Skate General 2020" and "World Skate Artistic Impression 2020".

- *Practical part*. The applicant will be asked to watch 2 videos (for each discipline they are taking the test for) and give the score for Show and/or give QOE and Components for the other disciplines.

IMPORTANT:

The same judge can apply for maximum two (2) disciplines.

For dance, the questions will be related to the pattern dances chosen for 2020 Junior and Senior Style Dances.

Written Part

- Unanswered questions will be counted as not correct.
- Some of the questions may require a free text answer.
- It is allowed 1 hour maximum for the written test for International judges.
- For those that want to apply to do two disciplines there will be 20 questions more (technical on the second discipline) and it will be allowed a total of 1:45 hours.

Practical Part

- For Figures there will not be a practical part.
- The examinees must demonstrate sureness analyzing a program and in scoring with the old system (Show) and/or scoring QOE and Components for the other disciplines.
- For both videos of each discipline chosen, the examinees must analyze and give good explanations for the QOEs and Components or the score (for Show).
