We are very pleased to announce that the Oceania Street Skateboarding Championship 2020 will be held in Melbourne, Australia, from February 13^{th} to 15^{th} 2020.

TOKYO 2020 QUALIFYING SYSTEM STATUS

This Event will form part of the Olympic Qualification Season #2 classified as Continental Championship.

VENUE

The competition will take place at:

EVENT CRITERIA

The event will comprise 2 competition rounds for both Men and Women: Qualifier and Final.

EVENT WILDCARDS

A limited number of Wildcards will be granted based on, but not limited to, a mix of criteria including competitive results, video submissions made to World Skate, host country citizenship, prior injuries, and/or a lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of skater's origin. Wild Card skaters per country may participate as Event Wildcards in the Qualifier.

All potential Wildcards must be free of sanctions and must apply by sending an email to platform@worldskate.org before February 4th at 11.59 PM CET

COUNTRY QUOTA

No country quota will limit National Federations from registering athletes.

COMPETITION FORMAT

OUALIFIER

The Qualifier round is open to skaters registered by World Skate recognized National Governing Body, and Event Wildcard holding athletes.

8 best ranked athletes from the Qualifier round will advance to the Final

Qualifier will be held in a 2run competition format. Best run counts for the ranking.

FINAL

The Olympic Street competition format, 2/5/4, will be applied to the Final.
