We are very pleased to announce that the Asian Street Skateboarding Continental Championship 2020 will be held in Singapore, from 19th to 23rd of February 2020.

TOKYO 2020 QUALIFYING SYSTEM STATUS

This Event will part of the Olympic Qualification Season #2 classified as Continental Championship.

VENUE

The competition will take place at:

Somerset Skatepark, located at 121 Somerset Road, Singapore

EVENT CRITERIA

The event will comprise 3 competition rounds for both Men and Women: Qualifier, Semifinal and Final

EVENT WILDCARDS

A limited number of Wildcards will be granted based on host country citizenship and/or a lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of skater's origin. Wild Card skaters per country may participate as Event Wildcards in the Qualifier.

All potential Wildcards must be free of sanctions and must apply by sending an email to platform@worldskate.org before February the 14th at 11.59 PM CET

The above schedule is open to changes according to the number of registered riders. A final and detailed schedule is going to be published after registrations are closed.

COUNTRY QUOTA

National Federations are allowed to register 6 Skaters per gender.

COMPETITION FORMAT

QUALIFIER

The Qualifier round is open to skaters registered by World Skate recognized National Governing Body, and Event Wildcard holding athletes.

The qualifier will be held in a 2-run competition format. The best run counts for the final ranking score.



A minimum of 24 best-ranked athletes from the Qualifier round will advance to the Semifinal and join the 8 pre-seeded riders in a 32 rider Semifinal.

SEMIFINAL

The Semifinal will be held in a 2-run competition format. The best run counts for the final ranking score.

8 best-ranked athletes from the Semifinal round will advance to the Final.

FINAL

The Final will be held in the Olympic Street competition format. Each rider will compete with 2 runs of 45 seconds and 5 individual trick attempts. 4 best scores are added together for the final ranking score.

SEMIFINAL SEEDING

The top 8 skaters representing Asian countries in the World Skateboarding Ranking (WSR) as of 1st of January, 2020 will be pre-seeded into the Semifinal competition round in both genders:

In case of no-show or inability to skate, athletes supposed to compete in Semifinal will be replaced with next ranked skater from the Qualifier.
