In case of no-show or inability to skate, athletes supposed to compete in Semifinal will be replaced with next ranked skater from the Qualifier.

REGISTRATION

The registration to the event will take place through the online World Skate Sports Entry Platform. The platform will open on **March 3rd at 00:00 am** and will close on **March 13th**

at 11.59 pm (CET).

EVENT WILDCARDS

A limited number of Wildcards will be granted based on host country citizenship and/or a lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of skater's origin. Wild Card skaters per country may participate as Event Wildcards in the Qualifier.

All potential Wildcards must be free of sanctions and must apply by sending an email to <u>platform@worldskate.org</u> before March 13th at 11.59 PM CET.

All the wild cards that have already been approved and have already completed the registration process, before the date was modified, do not need to apply nor register again unless they receive an official e mail from our Platform team.

TRAVEL

Airport pick up: All National Federations and skaters booking the official hotel through the above-mentioned link, will have the airport pick up service. The organization will provide daily transport from Changi Airport to the official hotel, LYF Funan.

There will be one morning and one afternoon transfer on 15th, 16th and 17th of March (timing TBC). The organizers will try their best to accommodate as many teams as possible especially with the differing flight schedules and arrivals at the 3 terminals.

If these arrangements do not suit your travel plans, we ask you to arrange you own transport to the hotel directly - taxis are readily available at reasonable expense.

There will be also airport transfer on the 21st and 22nd of March from LYF Funan to Changi Airport (timing TBC).

Competition Day Shuttle Service

The hotel is a short 24-minute walk to the skatepark and a 10-minute taxi ride.

For those that need it and have booked their stay at the official hotel, the organization will arrange for a shuttle bus that will pick up participants from LYF Funan Hotel and drop off at Somerset Skatepark on the 17-21 March, mornings and return in the evenings.

A bus schedule will be provided once the details are confirmed. For teams that arrive early and wish to have practice prior to contest week, they can make their own way to the skatepark.
