MEALS

ACCOMMODATION

In order to accommodate as many Extra Officials with the limited number of beds that the Organizers had available after accommodating the IF Passport Attendees, they have had to do the following:

- Doubling up except for odd number of males and/or females
- Restrict the stay of the attendees at UAB to the IF Passport period except for pre nights for the Opening Ceremony and post night for the Closing Ceremony.

Be sure to provide the check in date and check out date. Each attendee on the list will have a key fob to get them in the Hall. The fob will be activated per the date that is provided to them and will be deactivated at 10am on the check out date provided.
