We are pleased to share with you some general information regarding the upcoming event of The World Games that will be held in Birmingham, Alabama, USA from 7th to 17th July 2022.

SCHEDULE AND VENUE

REGISTRATION

International Federations are exclusively responsible for registering athletes, technical officials and supporting National Federation/Team officials. VISA invitation letters (if needed) are generated directly through the accreditation system (EMS).

Each participating International Federation has at least two credentials to access the EMS - one for the Competition Manager, one for the Office account. More accounts can be created on request by these two entities. It is recommended not to share EMS accounts with other persons.

EXTRA OFFICIALS:

Extra Team Officials are responsible for the costs of their accommodation, meals and transportation. The following options are available to extra team officials once they are approved by IWGA.

Option 1: Accreditation + Athlete's Village Accommodation Single 180\$ per day/person includes:

- Accommodation in a single room at the Athlete's Village
- Accreditation ID Card which allows access to the venues, athlete's village, opening and closing ceremonies, according to the access levels which are established for the cardholder by IWGA and BOC.
- 3 meals per day at the catering center on the campus at Athlete's Village
- Transportation within the Games transportation network (airport, venue, athlete's village)

Option 2: Accreditation + Athlete's Village Accommodation Double 120\$ per day/person includes:

- Accommodation in a double (shared) room at Athlete's Village.
- Accreditation ID Card which allows access to the venues, athlete's village, opening and closing ceremonies, according to the access levels which are established for the cardholder by IWGA and BOC.
- 3 meals per day at the catering center on the campus at Athlete's Village
- Transportation within the Games transportation network (airport, venue, athlete's village)

Option 3: Accreditation Only 55\$ per day/person

- Accreditation ID Card which allows access to the venues, athlete's village, opening and closing ceremonies, according to the access levels which are established for the cardholder by IWGA and BOC.
- 3 meals per day at the catering center on the campus at Athlete's Village
- Transportation within the Games transportation network (airport, venue, athlete's village)

In principle, athletes and IF Passport Officials from inside the USA will arrive two (2) days prior to the start (Arrival Day + Training Day). Athletes and IF Passport officials from outside the USA will arrive three (3) days prior to the start of their competition, with the right for a Jetlag Day.

Extra Officials consist of Team Officials (i.e. coaches, physicians, physiotherapists), further technicians or IF staff (i.e. IF media representatives).

Payment deadline (100%) for Extra Officials has been set for 20 May 2022. Registration will only be accepted once the payments are received and confirmed.
