#### WORLD SKATE ACADEMY: ARTISTIC SKATING

World Skate is glad to announce that different Online Courses will be available for Judges, Coaches, Technical Specialists and Data Operators.

The Online Courses will be held through an online platform.

All the classes are open to everyone.

## **COACHES**

On this opportunity, there will be lessons for World Skate Coaches Level 1, 2 and 3.

For Level 1 it is expected that the National Federations propose <u>two coaches</u> for each discipline (Free Skating, Pairs, Dance, Precision) to officially start the process.

Only those who have already passed level 1 can access the second level and only those who have passed level 1 and 2 can access level 3.

Anyone can attend these lessons but only coaches nominated by their National Federations will be officially recognized as World Skate Coaches.

The eligible candidates must complete the whole training prepared by World Skate (level 1, 2 and 3) and pass the exams in order to be recognised internationally as a World Skate Coach

These coaches will have the possibility to present courses at a National level, in their own country, with material provided by World Skate.

Eventually up to three coaches will be accepted for those nations where for the vastness of the territory need more places to meet the requirements of the project. The Artistic Technical Commission will analyse each situation and will decide if to approve three coaches instead of two.

Please note that the decision to confirm a nominated coach to participate at the World Skate Academy will be solely up to World Skate. The deadline for the National Federations to send the names and the information requested of the coach/es to artistic@worldskate.org is October 12<sup>th</sup> 2020.

At the end of level 3 there will be an online assessment test and it will be the last step to obtain the recognition.



## JUDGES, TECHNICAL SPECIALISTS AND DATA OPERATORS

For those who must participate to confirm their role (every two years) it is mandatory to follow all the lessons per discipline.

The attendees that complete the whole training of their discipline in cycle 1 and 2 and pass the exams will be recognized as International Judge, TS and DO. This means they will be taken into account to judge and be part of the judging panel at World Skate competitions.

The attendees that would like to take the exam, will have the opportunity to do it in person on their own continent. They must be registered by the National Federation of belonging.

More details will be published soon.

#### **GENERAL SCHEDULE**

The training period is divided in two cycles:

1<sup>st</sup> cycle: October - February 2020 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle: February - May 2021

Participants will have the opportunity to choose between two different lessons time according to their time zone and preferred language.

<u>Lessons will not be registered nor distributed and they must NOT be registered using other devices.</u>

\*Days might vary based on the return of the activities after the restrictions due to Covid-19.

#### **ENTRY FEES**

The following information is valid for both cycles:

single lesson: 40 USD2-lessons pack\*: 70 USD

There is no limit to the number of lessons that can be purchased.

The payment method will be PayPal, to be processed directly on the online platform. The system will allow you to use your PayPal account and/or your credit/debit card.

\*The 2-lessons pack is applicable to purchase 1 lesson per cycle for the same discipline.
