The beginning of the WORLD SKATE ACADEMY Rink Hockey Course for Referees is approaching very fast and we decided to share with you some additional information concerning the program of the course and its contents.

We would like also to rectify the info provided with Bulletin#01 concerning the Advanced and Elite Referees for whom it is not mandatory to attend the course to maintain their category.

REFEREES

The National Referees that complete the whole training and pass the exams will be recognized as International Referees and will be taken into account to referee World Skate competitions.

Please be informed that International Referees that have already achieved the “International” category must complete this course to confirm their own category.

The Advanced and Elite Referees do not have to attend the course to maintain their category. Starting from 2022, ALL referees will have to complete a refresher course every two years to confirm their category.

COURSE CONTENTS

World Skate International Referees Certification Project is a long-term plan to increase the skills and training qualities of referees worldwide.

On this opportunity, there will only 1 course.

The topics covered during the Course will be the following:

RINK HOCKEY REGULATION I:

- Apply the rules of the game correctly.



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COURT REFEREE SIGNALING

Goals:

- Documents are the official part of the referees' job.
- Explain the match sheet which is the official document which allows anyone to understand the progress of a match.
- Show the referee sheet which allows you to note everything related to the game.
- All these documents are useful especially in the event of disagreement.

PHYSICAL TRAINING


