COVID RISK MITIGATION PROVISIONS

In order to ensure athletes and staff safety and health, a “sport bubble” will be created. This will allow teams and staff will reside in isolation in order to participate at the Street World Championships safely during the current COVID-19 pandemic.

Athletes and all related personnel (including team managers, coaches, and NGBs staff members) must follow established safety regulations 24/7, whether they’re competing, practicing, or enjoying some downtime.

The “sport bubble” will be monitored by strict protocols for the health and safety of everyone involved.

“SPORT BUBBLE”: OFFICIAL HOTEL

In compliance with the COVID-19 containment measures, the COVID-19 Protocols of the government authorities, the accommodation must be booked following the instructions below:

Distance from the venue: 3.5 km

The price includes:

- accommodation in DUS room with breakfast
- dinner in hotel
- lunch at the venue starting from May 30th
- Dedicated transport: Hotel / Venue / Hotel
- Welcome desk for assistance and information

Tourist tax, Euro 6.00 per person per night, not included

Booking procedure:

In the subject of your email, please write:

Payment and cancellation terms:

- For reservations up to 5 rooms:

Credit card as guarantee to be provided at the time of booking. A charge with the pre-authorization of the amount of the entire stay will be made.

Payment of 30% to be made upon check-in.

Balance to be paid the evening before check out.

Free cancellation up to 4 days before the arrival date.

- For reservations from 6 rooms upwards:

Credit card as guarantee to be provided at the time of booking. Non-refundable confirmation deposit of 30% to be charged at the time of booking.

Payment of 50% to be made upon check in.

Balance to be paid the evening before check out.

Free cancellations by May 6th, except the non-refundable confirmation deposit.

From May 6th to 18th, it is possible to cancel up to a maximum of 3 rooms with relative meals.

From May 19th to 26th, it is possible to cancel up to a maximum of 2 rooms with relative meals.

Further cancellations, 100% penalty will apply.

Important: if you need to apply for your visa to Italy, we highly invite you to contact the hotel and make your reservation as soon as possible. We kindly ask you to forward the booking confirmation to skateboarding@fisr.it; operations@worldskate.org so that we will be able to issue your invitation letters to apply for your visa.

COVID-19 TESTS

Considering the local regulations and following the event protocol, all the tests will be done to the athletes and NGBs staff at the Hotel in a reserved room.

The first one will be on May 28th.

The additional control activities, testing days and safeguarding of the “sport bubble” conditions will be communicated subsequently in compliance with the protocol that is being defined with the local health authorities for adaptation to the upcoming new regulations in Italy.

We invite everyone to avoid recreational activities and / or at risk of contagion both before and after entering the bubble, otherwise we will nullify the protection measures adopted.

ACCREDITATION

Athletes and NGBs staff will pick up their accreditation for the event directly at the hotel on May 29th.

Pre-seeded athletes check in deadline remains June 2nd, the accreditation pick up will also be at the hotel.

Accreditation withdrawal with negative test results only. **No exceptions will be made.**

SELF-DECLARATION AND LETTER OF PARTICIPATION

We remind you that according to Article 51, paragraph 7 of PMD of March 2, 2021, provided that the persons travelling to Italy do not show any COVID-19 symptoms, the medical supervision and self-isolation do not apply to persons entering the Country in connection with sports events and competitions of national interest organised in accordance with ad hoc protocol adopted by the organiser of the event. Athletes and essential staff will not be subjected to quarantine or self-isolation if the following mandatory requirements and documents are presented:

1. They must fill out a self-declaration form ([Annex 2 Self Declaration](#)) and carry it with them upon arrival into Italy and throughout the entire duration of the event.

2. They must carry with them a certificate proving that they have taken a molecular or antigenic test carried out by means of a swab, **in the 48 hours before entering into Italy**, with negative results.
3. They must print out the **official letter of participation for the event** that will be sent to the email address of the Team Manager registered on the Sports Entry Platform. Each NGBs will receive a copy as well. The Team Manager will be in charge of forwarding the letters to all the registered persons. All registered persons must carry this letter with them upon arrival into Italy and throughout the entire duration of the event.
4. Sporting events must take place in accordance with relevant health and safety protocols adopted by the organization responsible for the event.

Please also check the regulations of your country should you need any travel and/or health insurance to travel into Italy.

Please note that if you do not present all the above-mentioned documents and requirements, there is no guarantee that you will be exempted from quarantine upon arrival into Italy.

During your stay in Italy, should any flu-like symptoms compatible with COVID-19 arise, you must report it immediately to the local Health Authority, by calling dedicated local numbers. While waiting for further Health Authority decisions, you must put yourself in self-isolation. Please also check the regulations of your country should you need any travel insurance to travel into Italy.

For this event, an amendment has been made:

Having considered all the restrictive measures in place due to the ongoing COVID19 pandemic and in order to ensure a fair, balanced and comprehensive participation in our events no replacements are allowed for qualifier events after the expiration of the registration deadline. Unfortunately, considering the strict waiver protocol for international travelers, in order to maintain the fair play and equal possibilities to all the participants, **no replacements will be allowed at any stage of the competition under any circumstances, including injuries and positive COVID-19 cases.**

Also, **event check-in** at the official hotel must be done individually, completing this process by the Team Manager will not be an option due to the COVID-19 protocols.
