1. PARTICIPATION FEES

a. Inline speed

Any National Federation, to be accepted to participate in the 4th African Championships of Inline Speed, will pay the following fees:

- Registration fee: US \$ 300
- Participation fee:
 - US \$ 100 for each **senior** skater registered for the Track Championships
 - US \$ 100 for each **senior** skater registered for the Road Championships
 - US \$ 50 for each **junior** skater registered for track championships
 - US \$ 50 for each **junior** skater registered for road championships
 - **US \$ 150 for each veteran skater man registered (master)**



b. Inline Freestyle

Any National Federation, to be accepted to participate in the 2nd African Championships of Inline Freestyle skating, will pay the following costs:

- Registration fee : US \$ 300
- Participation fee : US \$ 100 for each skater registered in the Inline Freestyle African Championships

+ Road race (juniors and seniors men and women)

- 100m sprint
- One Lap
- 10,000m points
- 15,000m elimination
- Marathon (42.195km)
- **Marathon (42.195km) master men**

b. INLINE FREESTYLE SKATING

- Slalom speed (juniors and seniors men and women)
- Slalom Battle (juniors and seniors men and women)
- Free Jump (men and women)



3. PASSPORT CONTROL AND PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION FEES

Passport checks and registration fee payments will take place upon arrival of each delegation.

4. TECHNICAL TRAINING

As a prelude to the championships, training will be organized for coaches and judges. The Beninese Roller Sports Federation will make all the material arrangements (a video projector, a laptop, a training room...) for the success of the training. Details will be communicated to you later.
