# WORLD SKATE ACADEMY: INLINE SPEED SKATING

We are pleased to announce that the World Skate Academy for Inline Speed Skating will start again in February 2022. We are confident that this initiative will be very enriching for the development of this beautiful sport in all participating countries. The program and contents will be run by the Inline Speed Skating Technical Commission.

The Online Courses will be available for Coaches and Judges and will be held through the Zoom online platform.

All attendees must be registered to the course by their National Federation of belonging, with no exception.

## COACHES

The World Skate Academy will be forming Coaches at all levels with the objective of developing the sport worldwide and take the level of competition to the highest.

The complete program will be divided into 3 (three) levels: 1, 2 and 3. Only the coaches appointed by their National Federations of belonging, after passing the pertinent exams and completing the 3 levels, will be officially recognized as World Skate Coaches.

These coaches should have the possibility to present courses at national level, in their own country, with the material provided by World Skate.

This year, there will be lessons for World Skate Coaches Level 1 and 2 only.

Level 1: National Federations are allowed to register an unlimited number of coaches but only **5** (five) of them will officially start the process as World Skate Coach.

Level 2: National Federations are allowed to register an unlimited number of coaches but only the **5** (five) coaches who already have the Certificate of Level 1 will officially continue the process as World Skate Coach.

On the registration website, the National Federations will have the option to indicate who are their 5 selected coaches that will officially start the process.

It remains up to the Inline Speed Skating Technical Commission to refuse any of the coaches proposed by the National Federation to start the official process.

SPEED TECHNICAL COMMISSION

The Online Course is addressed to both National and International Judges. It is mandatory for the judges to follow all the lessons to maintain their international judge category (renewal every two years).

There is no established limit of judges that can be registered by each National Federation.

## **GENERAL SCHEDULE**

The training period for the Coaches Level 1 and Level 2 programs is: 26 February - 26 March 2022.

Coaches will have the opportunity to choose between two different lessons times according to their time zone and preferred language (English or Spanish).

The training period for the National and International Judges programs is: 27 March - 23 April 2022.

Judges will have the opportunity to choose between two different lessons times according to their time zone. Judges course will be in English only.

All the lessons will be pre-recorded and shared live: the participants will be able to ask questions during the lessons, the questions will be sent to the speaker and the answers will be sent back to each participant within 2 working days.

At the end of each program, for both levels and categories, an Assessment will be required. More information concerning the evaluations will come soon.

The price of the Judges Online Course is 140 USD

### REGISTRATION

Each National Federation must register the attendees from their Country. Attendees must contact their National Federation of belonging to participate in the Online Course.

The registration website will automatically give the option to the National Federations for: 4

- "Registration and payment": The National Federation can register and pay for the attendees.
- "Registration only": the National Federation can only register the attendees (providing name, surname, country and e-mail address) and then each attendee must individually process the payment.

<u>The registration process will open by January 26</u>, and you will be able to access the registration web page <u>here</u>. On the website homepage you will find the Speed Skating User Guides for Attendees and National Federations.

Again, we invite all National Federations to start the selection of the 5 Coaches that could start the training with level 1.

We suggest to the National Federations to pay special attention to the contact email addresses of their coaches and write them correctly, as in case of an unforeseen setback, we might need to contact them directly to the e-mail addresses provided.
