WORLD SKATE ACADEMY: INLINE SPEED SKATING JUDGES

We are pleased to announce that the World Skate Academy for Inline Speed Skating Judges will start on April 2, 2022.

Online Courses will be available both for International and National Judges.

The Online Courses will be held through an online platform.

All attendees must be registered to the course by their National Federation of belonging, with no exception.

INTERNATIONAL JUDGES

Please be informed that:

- The Course will intend to update and standardize the INTERNATIONAL LEVEL
- Each National Federation can register all its of international judges.
- An international judge can be registered **only if included** in the official World Skate Inline Speed Skating International Judges List. The official list will be sent to all the NFs in the next days.
- This Course is mandatory to maintain the international judge category (renewal every two years). So, if you participated last year (in 2021) you do not need to attend again.
- The International Judges who will pass the final Assessment Test after attending the course will receive an official certificate and will be eligible to officiate International World Skate Competitions **only if** in line with the payment of the annual fees.
- There will not be examination to NEW International Judges.
- Only the International Judges will take the final Assessment Test.

NATIONAL JUDGES

- Each National Federation can register its National Judges (highest local category).
- The National Judges will obtain a "Certificate of Participation".
- It is mandatory to follow **all** the lessons of the course to obtain the Certificate.
- National Judges will NOT take the final Assessment Test.

GENERAL SCHEDULE

The training period for the Judges program is: from April 2, 2022 to April 23,2022

Participants will have the opportunity to choose between two different lessons time according to their time zone.

All the lessons will be live streamed only in the dates and times indicated in the schedule and the participants will be able to ask questions to the speakers at the end of each presentation.

ENTRY FEES

The price of the Online Course is 140 USD.

The payment method will be PayPal or Stripe, to be processed directly on the registration website. The system will allow you to use your PayPal account and/or your credit/debit card.

REGISTRATION

Each National Federation must register the attendees from their Country.

Attendees must contact their National Federation of belonging to participate in the Online Course.

The registration website will automatically give the option to the National Federations for:

- "Registration and payment": The National Federation can register and pay for the attendees.
- "Registration only": the National Federation can only register the attendees (providing name, surname, country and e-mail address) and then each attendee must individually process the payment.
