WORLD SKATE ACADEMY: INLINE SPEED SKATING

We are pleased to announce that the World Skate Academy for Inline Speed Skating will resume in March 2023. We are confident that this initiative will further enrich the development of this beautiful sport in all participating countries.

The program and contents will be defined and managed by the Inline Speed Skating Technical Commission.

The Online Courses will be available for Judges and Coaches.

The Online Courses will be held through a new platform. More detailed information will be available shortly.

JUDGES

The Online Course is addressed to both National and International Judges. As per the current rules, International Judges are those who took the Academy's Course in the academic year 2020-21 and/or 2021-22 and are actively officiating nationally or internationally (see the attachment's list here).

It is mandatory for International judges to follow all the lessons to maintain their International Judge category (renewal every two years). The Final Exam will determine the Category Level for the current year.

There is no pre-set limit in the number of judges that can be registered by each National Federation.

COACHES

The World Skate Academy will be training Coaches at all levels with the objective of developing the sport worldwide and increasing the level of competitions to the highest.

The complete program will be divided into 3 (three) levels: 1, 2 and 3. Only the coaches appointed by their National Federations, after passing the relevant exams and completing the 3 levels, will be officially recognized as World Skate Coaches.

These coaches should have the possibility to present courses at national level, in their own country, with the material provided by World Skate.



This year, there will be lessons for World Skate Coaches Level 1,2 and 3.

Level 1: National Federations are allowed to register an unlimited number of coaches but only **5** (**five**) of them will officially start the process as World Skate Coach.

Level 2: National Federations are allowed to register an unlimited number of coaches but only the **5** (five) coaches who already obtained the Certificate of Level 1 will officially continue the process as World Skate Coach.

Level 3: National Federations are allowed to register an unlimited number of coaches but only the **5** (five) coaches who already obtained the Certificate of Level 2 will officially continue the process as World Skate Coach.

National Federations will have to indicate their 5 selected coaches that will officially start the process through an online form that will be made available in due time.

It remains up to the Inline Speed Skating Technical Commission to reject any of the coaches proposed by the National Federation to start the official process.

LESSONS AND SCHEDULE

The training period for Judges will begin in March 2023. More details on course availability dates will be published at a later stage. Judges' course will be available in English only.

The dates for the training period of Coaches will be communicated at a later stage. Coach courses will be available both in English and Spanish.

All lessons will be pre-recorded and Participants will be able to attend them on the days and times of their choice.

At the end of Coach courses: an Assessment Test will be administered for Coaches Level 1 and Level 2 and 3; the 5 (five) Coaches selected by their National Federation to complete the process as World Skate Coach will take a Final Exam.

A Final Exam will take place at the end of Judges' course.

More information on the exams will be available at a later stage.



Please find below the initial information on the registration process; further details will be available in the coming weeks.

Attendees shall contact their National Federation to participate in the Online Course. National Federations shall indicate their 5 selected coaches that will officially start the process through an online form that will be made available in due time.

All attendees must be selected and registered by their National Federation with no exceptions.

The login credentials used on the previous website (Username and Password) will no longer be valid and all Participants will have to register again on the new platform. The registration link will be available in a future communication.

Each payment can be processed directly on the online platform by the Participants by means of PayPal or Stripe (using a credit or debit card).

Should National Federations need to pay the courses for their Participants, they shall inform us by means of an email to academy@worldskate.org on which participants and which courses the payment is made for; they will then be able to process the payment via bank transfer or credit card through a direct link.
