PARIS 2024 QUALIFYING SYSTEM STATUS

We are very pleased to announce that the first street event from the qualification path towards Paris 2024, will be held in Rome, Italy, from Sunday June 26th to Sunday July 3rd, 2022.

This Event will be classified as a Pro Tour.

VISA

Regarding VISA requests, we recommend you check “Visas by Invitation” (*V.S.U. - Visto per Invito*) with the Italian embassy/consulate of your country.

Please note that invitation letters can be issued only after performing the registration on the new World Skate Sports Entry Platform: “Infinity”. No exceptions can be made.

COUNTRY QUOTA

National Federations are allowed to register **6 athletes** per gender.
Pre-seeded skaters do not count against the Country Quota registration limit.



SEEDING STRUCTURE

The TOP 5 ranked athletes in the [Olympic World Skate Ranking \(OWSR\)](#) as of today, and Tokyo2020 Olympic Games medalists, will skip the Open Qualifier and will be pre-seeded directly into a following competition phase.


Skaters ranked 6th to 30th will be seeded to the **Open Qualifier**.

Pre-seeded skaters (1st to 5th from the OWSR and medalists) are exempted from paying the registration fee and must check in at the competition by the following deadline:

- **June 29th 2022 at 03:00 pm**

In case of no-show or inability to compete, pre-seeded skaters will be replaced with the next ranked rider from the Open Qualifier results.

- ALL pre-seeded skaters (ranked 1st to 30th) are required to sign up to Infinity and create their own profile, same as all participants. However, their respective Federations will have to confirm or refuse their participation within Infinity and pay the registration fee. They will **not** count against their National Federation's country quota.

REGISTRATION

The new World Skate Sports Registration system "Infinity" will be used for the registration process.

A Beta version of the system ([desktop](#), [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and [App Store \(iOS\)](#)) was released in April.

The Registration Process for this event will be launched shortly. All NFs will be notified by email.

All National Federations governing Skateboarding who haven't as yet received one shall receive an invitation to set up their NF Admin profile (please check spam folders!).

Should you not have received the invitation, or should you have any issue in completing the procedure, please contact us at platform@worldskate.org.

We encourage you to complete the NF Admins to establish those profiles ASAP, otherwise relevant individual users (Athletes and National Team Members) will not be eligible for registration to the event.

Individual Users can sign up to the system via the following link:

<https://infinity.worldskate.org/sign-up> or through the World Skate Infinity app (available on [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and the [App Store \(iOS\)](#)).

Individual users are Athletes, Presidents, Secretaries-General, Coaches, Doctors and any other National Federation Member who will participate in this or any forthcoming events representing their Federation of belonging. Each must sign up individually (they will be notified by email when the process is available), complete the procedure and be approved by their relevant NF (approval needed for Athletes only).

This process will open in the coming days and all relevant parties will be notified of the same via email.

Once Athletes and National Team Members have completed their profile on Infinity, they will be eligible to be registered for the event by their relevant National Federation.

The registration process is easy and the interface is very user friendly; however, since all of this is new to everyone, we are at your disposal should you need assistance.

A webinar to help National Federations familiarize with the new Infinity System will be held in the next weeks and a PDF user guide will be made available before launching the registration process.

User guides are just examples, the actual flow might be slightly different.

The online payment functionality is now available on Infinity.

MINOR'S PARENTS / LEGAL GUARDIANS

Minor's (U18) parents or legal guardians will be able to register to the event by clicking [here](#).

Only **one legal guardian or parent** per minor athlete can be registered.

Only after completing the registration should they follow the procedure explained above to obtain the Visa if needed.

Registration deadline is **June 21st 2022.**

The legal guardian/parent is expected to be present with their relevant athlete each day at their required registration time to sign documents.

ACCOMMODATION

Provided no COVID 19 restrictions come into place, recommended hotel information will follow shortly.

ENTRY FEE

Each participating athlete will pay the following fee: 200 USD
Please find the payment methods on the registration platform.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2020, 2021 and 2022 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the [WADA ADEL platform](#) and complete the relevant Course.

We remind you that the [WADA ADEL platform](#) is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.


