The beautiful cities of Buenos Aires, Vicente Lopez and San Juan will host a unique event in which thousands of talented athletes will compete for the title of World Champion.

PROVISIONAL CALENDAR

By clicking on the following [link](#) you can find the provisional calendar of the World Skate Games 2022. We await the 31st May for the intention of the team sports (Inline Hockey, Roller Derby and Rink Hockey) to participate so that the Technical commissions could prepare a proper calendar.

REGISTRATION

The new World Skate Sports Registration system “Infinity” will be used for the registration process.

A Beta version of the system ([desktop](#), [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and [App Store \(iOS\)](#)) was released in April (as per the communications sent to all NFs).

The dates for the Registration Process will be communicated at a later stage.

All National Federations have received an invitation to set up their NF Admin profile (please check spam folders!).

Should you not have received the invitation, or should you have any issue in completing the procedure, please contact us at platform@worldskate.org.

We encourage you to complete the NF Admins to establish those profiles ASAP, otherwise relevant individual users (Athletes and National Team Members) will not be eligible for registration to the event.

Individual users are Athletes, Presidents, Secretaries-General, Coaches, Doctors and any other National Federation Member who will participate in this or any forthcoming events representing their Federation of belonging. Each must sign up individually, complete the procedure and be approved by their relevant NF (approval needed for Athletes only).

The single users' sign up process is currently limited to Artistic Skating and Skateboarding; therefore, we kindly ask you to wait until further communication via email.

Once available, individual Users will be able to sign up to the system via the following link: <https://infinity.worldskate.org/sign-up> or through the World Skate Infinity app (available on [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and the [App Store \(iOS\)](#)).

Once Athletes and National Team Members have completed their profile on Infinity, they will be eligible to be registered for the event by their relevant National Federation.

The registration process is easy and the interface is very user friendly; however, since all of this is new to everyone, we are at your disposal should you need assistance. For any help or clarification you may need please contact us at platform@worldskate.org.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager.

During the sign up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2020, 2021 and 2022 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the [WADA ADEL platform](#) and complete the relevant Course.

We remind you that the [WADA ADEL platform](#) is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support
