We are glad to share some general information regarding the upcoming World Skate Games 2022 that will take place in Argentina from 24th October to 13th November for the Scootering discipline.

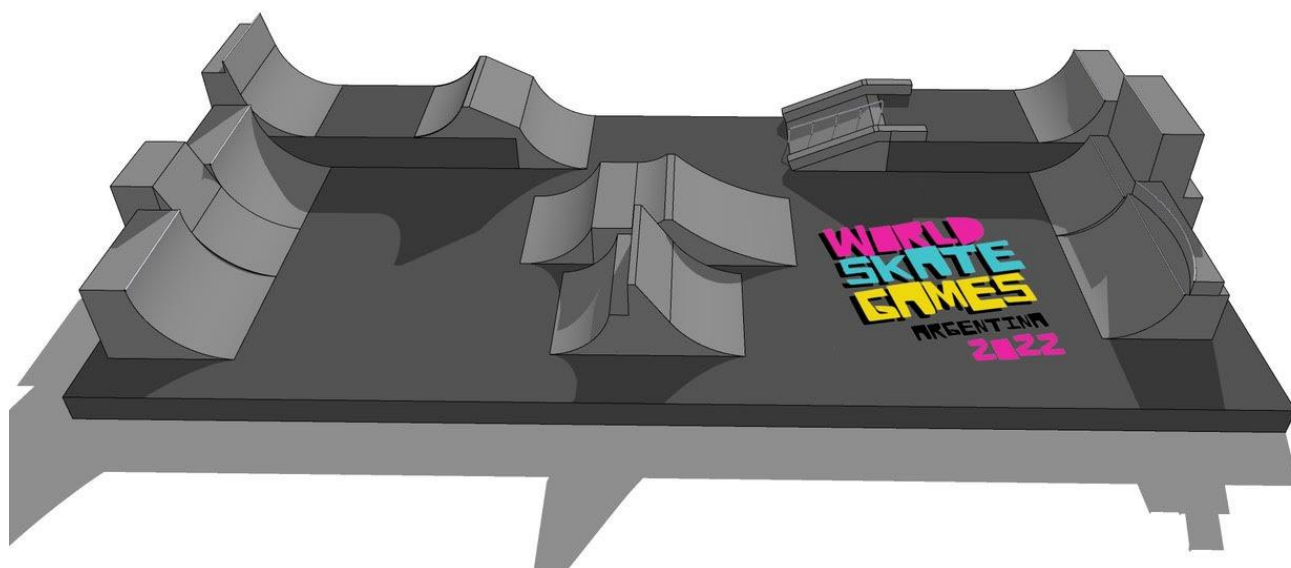
## VENUE AND LAYOUT

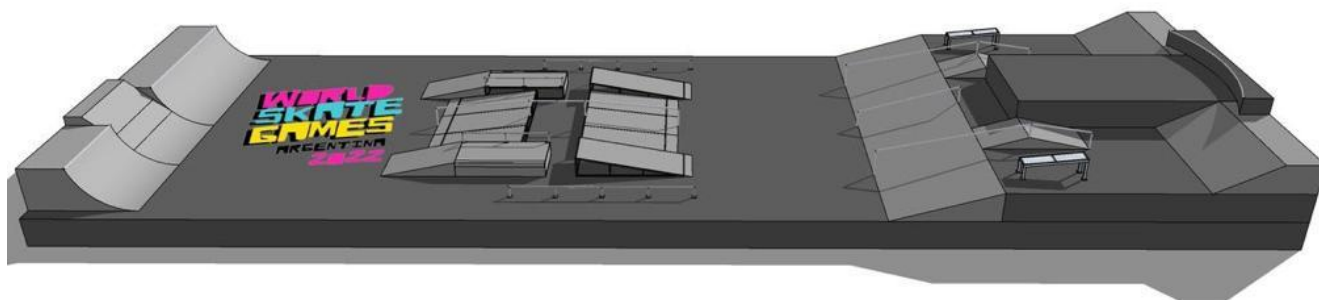
The event will be held at *Puerto Madero*.

## REGISTRATION

---

### Registration for pre-seeded riders:

Pre-seeded Athletes must create a profile in World Skate Infinity, uploading all necessary data and information. They can sign up in the system from the following link: <https://infinity.worldskate.org/sign-up> or through the World Skate Infinity app (available on [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and [App Store \(iOS\)](#)). The athletes must then be confirmed by their National Federation of belonging in the system. World Skate will then register them for the event, and the National Federation will confirm their attendance through the system.

**How quota riders register through their National Federation:**

The registration process will be carried out through World Skate Infinity, our new Sports Registration Platform. World Skate Infinity is available on desktop (browser) and App Version on Play Store (Android) and App Store (iOS).

Single Users (Athletes, National Team Members) must individually sign up in the App or desktop version and create a profile, with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents; passport copy, profile picture (headshot), AD Training Course Certificate.

In case of an Anti-Doping Course Certificate released before 2020 or should anyone need to take the course, here's the link to WADA's ADEL platform: <https://adel.wada-ama.org/learn>. We remind you that WADA's ADEL Platform is not managed by World Skate, therefore all support requests must be sent directly to WADA.

In case of underage single users (under 18 years old), they will need the assistance of a parent/legal guardian who will also have to submit his/her data and Passport copy. Any single user who fails to complete the above-mentioned steps will not be eligible for event registration. National Federations must confirm all Athletes as their members within Infinity (desktop version), otherwise they will not be able to register them for the event.

#### **How riders can register without a National Federation:**

Athletes who are from a country where there is no National Governing Body for Scooter may apply for a wildcard by writing to [platform@worldskate.org](mailto:platform@worldskate.org) before the registration deadline.

#### **Park (Qualifier and Semi-Finals):**

2x 45 second runs  
Better run counts

#### **Park (Finals):**

2x 45 second runs plus best trick  
Better run counts

#### **Street (Qualifier, Semi-Finals, Finals):**

**Qualifier :** 2x 45 second runs (Best run counts)

**Semi-finals :** 2 rounds of 1 x 45 seconds run + 1x best trick), best round counts

**Finals:** 2x 45 second runs + 5x best trick, best 3 scores count (1 run score + 2 best tricks)
