PARIS 2024 QUALIFYING SYSTEM STATUS

We are pleased to announce that both Park and Street World Championships 2022 will take place in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

The **Park World Championships** will be the first park event on the qualification path towards Paris 2024 and will take place from **October 2nd to 9th**.

The **Street World Championships** will take place from **October 9th to 16th**, and are the second Street qualification event towards Paris 2024.

Both events are classified as World Championships.

Although these are public skateparks, the organizers advise that the skateparks will be closed for maintenance and construction, in preparation for the events.

Please note that the Duó Skatepark will undergo refurbishment and upgrade prior to the event. Despite these works not being conducted under the authority and the coordination of World Skate, knowing that various teams are planning training sessions in RDJ before the event, we would like advise of the following calendar of closures:

- **Park Skatepark - closed between 12/09/2022 and 01/10/2022**
- **Street Skatepark - closed between 02/08/2022 and 08/10/2022**

COUNTRY QUOTA

National Federations are allowed to register **6 athletes** per gender per discipline. Pre-seeded skaters do not count against the Country Quota registration limit.

- ALL pre-seeded skaters (ranked 1st to 30th) are required to sign up to Infinity and create their own profile, same as all participants. However, their respective Federations will have to confirm or refuse their participation within Infinity and pay the registration fee. They will **not** count against their National Federation's country quota.

REGISTRATION

The registration process will be carried out through World Skate Infinity, our new Sports Registration Platform and will be open **from August 30th at 00.00am (CET) to September 20th at 11.59pm (CET).**

World Skate Infinity is available on [desktop](#) (browser) and App Version on [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and [App Store \(iOS\)](#).

Single Users (Athletes, National Team Members) must individually sign up in the App or desktop version and create a profile, with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents; passport copy, profile picture (headshot), AD Training Course Certificate.

Each National Federation must confirm the participation of its Pre-seeded Athletes within the World Skate Infinity Platform (browser version).

In case of an Anti-Doping Course Certificate released before 2020 or should anyone need to take the course, here's the link to WADA's ADEL platform: <https://adel.wada-ama.org/learn>.

We remind you that WADA's ADEL Platform is not managed by World Skate, therefore all support requests must be sent directly to WADA.

In case of underage single users (under 18 years old), they will need the assistance of a parent/legal guardian who will also have to submit his/her data and Passport copy.

Any single user who fails to complete the above-mentioned steps will not be eligible for event registration. For more details regarding the single user sign up process, please watch this video: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=meHkSVuitUI>.

National Federations must confirm all Athletes as their members within Infinity (desktop version), otherwise they will not be able to register them for the event.

Wild Card requests must be sent by e-mail to platform@worldskate.org within **September 20th**.

The online payment functionality is now available on Infinity.

MINOR'S PARENTS / LEGAL GUARDIANS

Minor's (U18) parents or legal guardians will be able to register to the event by clicking [here](#).

Only **one legal guardian or parent** per minor athlete can be registered.

Only after completing the registration, should they follow the procedure explained above to obtain the Visa if needed.

Registration deadline is **September 20th, 2022**.

The legal guardian/parent is expected to be present with their relevant athlete each day at their required registration time to sign documents.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2020, 2021 and 2022 are accepted.
Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the [WADA ADEL platform](#) and complete the relevant Course.

We remind you that the [WADA ADEL platform](#) is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.


