| 3, Categories | "If a rider has registered for... a World Skate Ranking event, they will no longer...." | "...a World Skate Ranking event or Continental Championship, they will no longer..." |
| 9, Athlete Safety Equipment | Helmets must be worn by all park and Vert athletes, regardless of age and competition category, and all Street athletes 17 years of age or under. | Helmets must be worn by all Street, Park and Vert athletes, regardless of age and competition category. |
| 9, Athlete Safety Equipment | Appropriate clothing, including proper footwear and attire, must be worn during all competition rounds. Competing topless is not allowed. | ...must be worn during all practice sessions and competition rounds. Practicing or competing topless is not permitted. |
| 12, Athlete Meetings | The TD will host such meetings in conjunction with the Head Judge and the Event Director | The TD will host such meetings in conjunction with the Head Judge and Technical Commission |
| 14, Boundaries of Performance | Athletes are strictly forbidden from riding in between runs | ...from riding in between runs, or between tricks in the 2/3/2 format |
| 15, Street discipline competition formats | Athletes can decide to not have their trick scored if they intend to improve it with a later attempt | ...with a later attempt, but this will still use up one of their allocated attempts |
| 16, Seeding Order & Round Structure | Any athletes who have not checked in by the end of the final practice session for the relevant category and discipline will be removed from the competition... | ...not checked in more than one hour before the first competition round for the relevant category and discipline will be removed from the competition... |
| 18, Timekeeping | A trick or bail will be considered in time only when the athlete has already left the ground to attempt a trick before the signal horn is sounded unless otherwise specified by the head judge. | ...to attempt a trick before the run time expires unless otherwise specified by the head judge... and additional considerations may be communicated in a pre-competition athlete meeting |
| 19, Athlete withdrawal & replacement | Replacements are possible only for quarterfinal and semifinal rounds; replacements are not allowed for the final round of competition | Replacements are only possible up to one hour before the first round of the relevant competition begins. This must be a like-for-like replacement made by the National Federation for an athlete |
