



Roller Freestyle World Ranking System

The Roller Freestyle World Ranking System measures the performance of athletes competing in the Men's, Women's, Junior Men's and Junior Women's categories by awarding points for final results achieved at official World Skate Ranking events worldwide. An athlete's cumulative points total determines their current World Ranking position and is used for pre-seeding at future events.

World Ranking points may be earned at three tiers of events, in descending order of value: World Championships, World Cup, and Challenger events.

The Rankings operate on a rolling two-year cycle. The 2024-2025 Rankings are therefore calculated using results from events held in 2024 and 2025. Following the first Ranking event of 2026, all results from 2024 will expire, and the Rankings will transition to the 2025-2026 cycle.

Wherever a tie occurs in the World Rankings, it shall be broken by reference to the athlete's most recent World Championships result.

When a Junior athlete moves into the Men's or Women's category, all Junior ranking points shall be nullified and the athlete shall be removed from the Junior World Rankings. The athlete will then begin accumulating ranking points in the Men's or Women's Rankings from zero.

Likewise, when the World Rankings are updated following an event, any Junior athlete who has reached 17 years of age since the previous update shall have their Junior ranking points nullified and shall be removed from the Junior World Rankings.
