5, Country Quota Athletes	Quota for Pro Tour: Men's/Women's: min 5 per NGB; Junior: min 3 per NGB	Quota and entry requirements for each World Cup event will be determined by the Technical Commission, considering various factors including the schedule, Field of Play (FOP) and other considerations, and will be communicated via official bulletins ahead of each event.
9, Athlete Safety Equipment	Appropriate clothing, including proper footwear and attire, must be worn during all competition rounds. Competing topless is not allowed.	...must be worn during all practice sessions and competition rounds. Practicing or competing topless is not permitted.
15, Street discipline competition formats	Final: 1+1 or 2/3/3	Final: Run, 1+1, 2/3/3
16, Makes versus Bails	The head judge is the final decision maker in identifying made tricks versus bailed tricks	A make is when the rider has landed a trick with both wheels on the ground in a forward direction in complete control of their scooter. Anything different to this may be classed as a bail. The head judge is the final decision maker in identifying made tricks versus bailed tricks

		and completed combinations versus failed combinations.
18, Timekeeping	The clock is triggered by the timekeeper following a countdown from the course manager or on-site commentator.	The clock is triggered when a rider drops in following a countdown from the course manager or on-site commentator
19, Athlete withdrawal & replacement	Replacements are possible only for quarterfinal and semifinal rounds; replacements are not allowed for the final round of competition	Replacements are only possible up to one hour before the first round of the relevant competition begins.
20, WDW	Athletes that did the event check-in but later withdrew from the competition will be ranked according to the last competition round they have checked into.	...will be ranked according to the last competition round they participated in.

## ADDITIONS

Page, Item	New
3, Categories	Athletes below the current minimum age limits who appeared in the World Rankings prior to 31 December 2025, having participated under the previous competition rules, shall remain eligible to compete irrespective of their present age.
14, Boundaries of Performance	All trick attempts must start and finish within the FOP boundaries to count. Tricks completed outside the FOP will not be scored.
18, Timekeeping	If a rider is performing a combination when the course timer expires, they are permitted to complete the combination, and it can still be scored. However, the rider cannot choose to extend the combination with a linking trick such as another manual or fakie; they may only trick out of the current combination. Any extension after the timer will invalidate the entire combination.
19, Competition Check-in	Riders will be removed from competition if they have not completed Event Check-in at least one hour before the beginning of the first round of their relevant competition.
