The following document complements the Qualification Rules released by the IOC on the 1st of April 2022.

Please note that all the numbers and quota places presented in this document refer to each of the single Olympic disciplines and their gender categories.

## EVENT TIERS

Only Pro Tour, Olympic Qualifying Series and World Championships events will be sanctioned during the qualification period for Paris 2024 Summer Olympic Games (OG).

## SEASONS AND PHASES OF QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

The qualification system of Paris 2024 OG is composed of 3 seasons (2022, 2023 and 2024) assembled of 2 phases structured as follows :

PHASE	Start date	End date
Phase 1	22nd of June 2022	31st of January 2024
Phase 2	1st of February 2024	23rd of June 2024

## OWSR DEFINITIONS

The following definitions apply to the Olympic World Skateboarding Ranking

**Event Result** - Is the rank each athlete is listed as in the final event results

**Event Points** - Are the points allocated in the OWSR to each athlete based on their Event Results and the “PARIS 2024 SKATEBOARDING QUALIFICATION POINT SYSTEM” available [here](#) on [www.worldskate.org](http://www.worldskate.org).

The currently available document includes only Pro Tour (PT) and World Championships (WCH) event tier points and will be further updated upon the release of the Phase 2 event calendar along with the Olympic Qualifier Series point system scheme.

**OWSR** - the Olympic World Skateboarding Ranking is defined by adding the athletes’ event points. During Phase 1, depending on the final number of the events held per discipline, the following criteria will be applied for OWSR calculation:

## EVENTS CALENDAR

The Olympic Qualification process is assembled in 2 phases.

### Phase 1

All the events held between 22 June 2022 and 31 January 2024 will contribute to the Olympic World Skateboarding Ranking (OWSR) points accumulation of Phase 1.

The participation to the events of Phase 1 is open to the athletes registered by the World Skate recognized National Governing Bodies (NGBs), within the event registration rules and the imposed country quota limits.



The following table presents the events that have been already completed as part of the Phase 1 of the qualification system of the Paris 2024 OG held, in between June 2022 and January 2023

\* **TBA** stands for To Be Announced. A TBA event is confirmed but the specific details still need to be finalized before a definitive announcement can be made.

\* **TBC** stands for To Be Confirmed. World Skate is actively working on securing such an event. A TBC event will either be: confirmed with details to be announced, or canceled. Further information will be provided as soon as available.

\* **WCH or PT** stands for events that will either be Pro Tour or World Championships. Further information on the event tier status will be provided by April 1st 2023

## Phase 2

All events held between the 1st of February 2024 and the 23rd of June 2024 will contribute to the Phase 2 OWSR points accumulation.

The participation to Phase 2 events will be open only to the 44 of athletes qualified nominally by their OWSR ranking position at the completion of all Phase 1 events.

Phase 2 athletes will not coincide with the top 44 OWSR athletes but, similarly to the Olympic Games qualification rules, a series of quota places and eligibility criteria will be applied in their selection. The quota system and selection procedure for Phase 2 events are being composed in close cooperation of the IOC together with the WSK Sports Department.


