COACH DEVELOPMENT MISSION

To make skateboarding more accessible and provide safeguarding of Olympic skateboard coaching practice through the inclusive availability of a recognised learning pathway that is aligned to an international accreditation standard.

CERTIFICATION VISION

- > Implement a process for National Federations to align their Olympic skateboarding coach education pathways to an international equivalency standard (CEAS)
- > Ensure a consistently high quality of delivery for every coaching program recognised to meet CEAS standards
- > Establish a dynamic global network of growing and evolving coach educators and delivery partners



ELIGIBILITY AND SCOPE



National Federations with an established history and proven track record in skateboard coach education, formally recognized by their **National Olympic Committee** or corresponding entities governing national sport, may apply

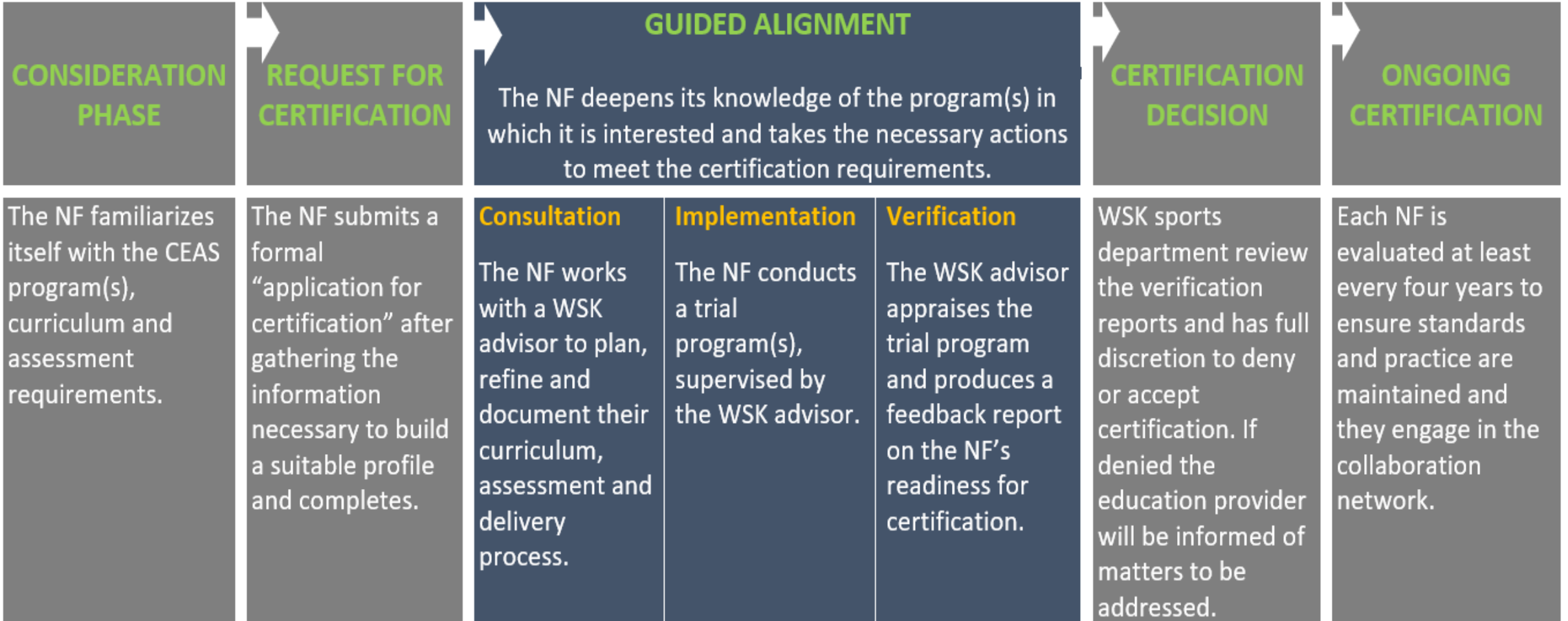


CEP status is reserved for **national-level educational activity**; accredited courses can only be delivered within the certified host nation



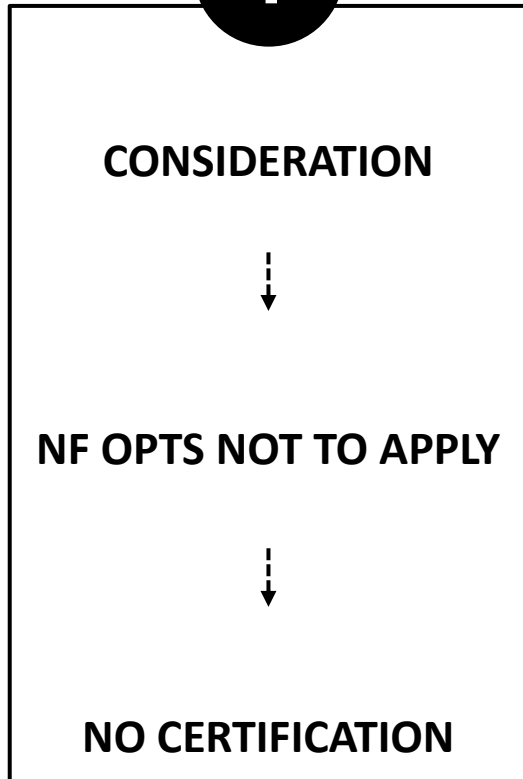
World Skate retains authority over the recognition of all global in-person and on-line coaching programs to ensure consistent quality and oversight

RESPONSIBILITIES AND REQUIREMENTS



Appoint a local **education coordinator** for liaison with WSK



Staff must complete WSK-approved **educator training** or equivalent



Programs must align with:
CEAS Content, Learning Time, Assessment Methods and Philosophy



Providers must demonstrate community and institutional support, and **financial sustainability**

CEP BENEFITS

NATIONAL FEDERATIONS

- Use of a **dedicated WSK badge of recognition** for local coaching programs aligned to the equivalent CEAS Level 1 and/or Level 2
- Expanded means to develop national coaching pathways through **access to curriculum, assessment toolkits, teaching materials, and international forums** provided by World Skate
- Strengthened capacity to promote **high-quality coaches** within each country and verify the national team workforce

COACHES

- **Validation and recognition of qualification** and coach level by WSK, valid for domestic governing bodies when coaching abroad
- Coaches able to be officially certified and **included in a publicly accessible WSK Coaching Database**, enhancing visibility and career advancement opportunities



FEE STRUCTURE

REQUEST FOR CERTIFICATION

- One off cost per CEAS level
- Audit against requirements
- WSK authorisation decision

INDIVIDUAL COACH INTERNATIONAL REGISTRATION

- Annual public database listing fee
- Profile maintenance

\$50

GUIDED ALIGNMENT

- Fee determined case-by-case
- Dependant on NF program status and necessary alignment work

\$0-5,000

ON-GOING CERTIFICATION

- Quadrennial NF fee per CEAS level
- Discount for both levels (\$400)
