# REGISTRATION PROCESS

The National Federation must first register the Judges by completing the nomination form, attached <u>HERE</u>, listing the names of the Judges they want to nominate.

After submitting the form, the Federation must pay the registration fee for the Judges via bank transfer or PayPal.

Please refer to the payment section below for details.

Once the payment is confirmed, the Judges must sign up and create a profile on our Academy platform using the following link:

After completing their profiles, Judges should send a confirmation email to:

Our staff will verify the payment status and proceed to add the exam page to the profile.

The WSK JUDGING CERTIFICATION testing fee is **USD 60** per registered candidate and one test per discipline.

The NGB must cover two testing fees if some candidates are registered for both disciplines.

Each Continental Area's Discipline test will be open for 3 hours and closed afterward. Candidates who do not finish the online test within this allocated time will not be eligible for certification.

## JUDGING CERTIFICATION TEST WILL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Theoretical knowledge test part:
  - WSK competition rules,
  - Judging criteria,
  - o overall Skateboarding Common Sense
- 2. Practical test of skateboard judging part:
  - Judging Men & Women categories in a simulated competition environment with traditionally used event formats and judging methods
- 3. Note-taking accuracy test part:
  - Test of the candidate's note-taking abilities and their accuracy

# REQUIREMENTS

All NGBs must ensure their candidates are provided with or have:

- A stable internet connection to access and conduct the online testing,
- A computer (personal desk computer, laptop, or iPad.) Smartphones are not recommended.
- Supporting office supplies like pens, notebooks, etc., are available during test time.

Suppose some candidates do not possess or miss some of the necessary technological provisions during their testing slot time and cannot conduct or complete the Online testing. In that case, they will not be eligible for another testing session attempt and will be marked as DID NOT PASS in the online testing.





## All candidates for the WSK JCP Level 01 candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Active or passive (with previous active career) skateboarders
- between 18 and 40 years of age,
- ideally with personal experience in competitive skateboarding.
- A minimum of 2 years of judging experience at the national or national championships tier of events.
- Good level of communication in English
- All eligible candidates shall comply with the WSK Code of Conduct for Skateboard
  Judges and not hold any position that may conflict with their role as judges at
  skateboarding events. Especially in the following positions:
  - National Federation / National Governing Body officials and staff.
  - Agents of any Athlete,
  - Coaches or other supporting staff,
  - Team or Marketing managers in skateboard or skateboard industry-related companies,
