



# LA28 Olympic Games - Skateboarding: Phase 2 Qualification & Participation Criteria

## WORLD SKATE (WSK)

### Skateboarding

#### A. EVENTS (4)

An event is defined as a specific discipline (Park or Street) for a specific gender. There are four (4) distinct events part of Phase 2

##### B.1. Total quota places for Skateboarding Park:

**B.3. Type of allocation of quota places:**

Quota places are allocated to the athlete(s) by name.

**C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY**

All athletes must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions).

Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the IOC, plus the rules of World Skate, may participate in the Olympic Qualifier Series.

**C.1. Additional IF eligibility criteria**

Athletes must also comply with the following criteria:

- Be listed by name in the World Skateboarding Rankings (WSR) on the website [here](#) as of **31 March 2028** in the respective discipline.
- Must be a recognized member of their National Federation, as by the National Governing body standards and procedures.
- All competing athletes at the LA28 Olympic Games must have been born on or before 31 December 2014 with the date validated by the passport used for the event registration process

**D. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY**

The Women’s Park and Street events and Men’s Park and Street events will each be comprised of exactly 44 athletes:

**D.1. QUOTA PLACES**

## D.2. LOS ANGELES 2028 HOST COUNTRY PLACES

The Los Angeles 2028 OG host country is guaranteed one (1) athlete in each of the women’s and men’s events, if not already otherwise qualified. The athlete selected by name shall be the highest ranked athlete from the host country listed on the World Skateboarding Rankings as of 31 March 2028. In the event, there is no athlete from the host country listed on the Olympic World Skateboarding Rankings, World Skate will, in collaboration with the host country National Federation, identify the athlete(s) to represent the host country.

## D.3. PHASE 2 EVENTS HOST COUNTRY PLACES

Each Phase 2 host country is guaranteed one (1) athlete place for the men’s and women’s events, limited to the specific discipline(s) they are hosting, if not already otherwise qualified. The athlete selected by name shall be the highest ranked athlete from the host country listed on the World Skateboarding Rankings as of 31 March 2028. In the event, there are no athletes from the host countries listed on the Olympic World Skateboarding Rankings, the quotas will be reallocated as by D.1.

### Athletes Eligibility:

To qualify for the Phase 2 Host Countries quota places, athletes must meet one of two ranking criteria: either they must be ranked in the top 75% of the WSR, or they must be ranked within the top 75 spots, whichever of the two yields the lowest ranking. For instance, if the WSR for Women Street Female has 120 positions ranked, then the eligibility criteria would be set at the 90th ranking.

## E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

World Skate will publish the WSR [here](#) during the entire qualification period prior to the qualification deadline. The qualification period will end on 31 March 2028 and World Skate will update the final WSRs at the latest on 3 April 2028 or in any case within the 72h following the conclusion of all eligible WSR events part of Phase 1.



Upon publication of the final WSR, World Skate will send the confirmation of the quota places obtained in accordance with the qualification criteria outlined in Section D above to the respective NFs, no later than 7 April 2028 24:00 Central European Standard Time.

No later than 11 April 2028 at 22:00 Central European Standard Time each NF will have to confirm to World Skate the athlete places that they will use.

As of 12 April 2028, Central European Standard Time World Skate will commence the reallocation of all unused quota places.

## F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

If a quota place allocated is not confirmed by the NF by the confirmation of quota place deadline or is declined by the NF or for any other reason can't be assigned, it will be reallocated to the highest ranked athlete by name on the WSR of 31 March 2028 not already qualified, and respecting the maximum quota per country per event and respecting the continental representation (as determined under Section B and D above). No later than the start of the first Phase 2 event Technical Meeting, World Skate will reallocate all unused quota places.
