SPEED WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS 2023

Dear Sir/Madam,

We are glad to announce the upcoming event: Speed World Championships 2023 that will take place in Montecchio Maggiore/Vicenza from 26th of August to 3rd of September.

LOCATION

The events will take place in the following locations:

- **Track:** *Pattinodromo comunale di Alte Montecchio Maggiore 30675, Via Volta 94*
- **Road circuit:** *Ramonda Arena, Viale Trieste 45, 36075 Alte Montecchio Maggiore*
- **Marathon:** the marathon will take place in the city circuit - 4,7 km start and finish line at *Duomo Montecchio, Montecchio Maggiore*
- **100m Sprint Race:** Vicenza

COUNTRY QUOTA

As follows you will find the maximum skaters registrations per National Team for both Track and Road:

Senior men: 8 skaters

Senior women: 8 skaters

Junior men: 8 skaters

Junior women: 8 skaters

Please note that:

- Only 2 skaters per National Team may take part in the races.
- Only 3 or 4 skaters per National Team may be registered in the Relay Race.

For the **Marathon** each National team can register:

- A maximum of 16 male skaters
- A maximum of 16 female skaters

All registered skaters may take part in the Marathon race.

REGISTRATION DATES & MODALITY

The new World Skate system Infinity will be used for the registration process.

Athletes and National Technical Officials will be asked to sign up on their own and create their profile before their National Federation of belonging will be enabled to select them for the event.

Single users are Athletes, Presidents, Secretaries-General, Coaches, Doctors and any other National Federation Member who will participate in this or in the forthcoming events representing their Federation of belonging and must sign up individually and on their own in the system, complete the procedure and be approved by their NF of belonging. Single Users can sign up in the system from the following link: <https://infinity.worldskate.org/sign-up> or through the World Skate Infinity app (available on [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and [App Store \(iOS\)](#)).

Once Athletes and National Team Members have completed their profile on Infinity, they will be eligible to be registered for the event by their National Federation of belonging.

Payments will be processed through Infinity by credit card or bank transfer.

Registration dates:

July 10th - August 7th

ENTRY FEES

Each participating country will pay the following entry fees:

- 400 USD for each country participating at the Senior Championships
- 100 USD for each Senior skater entered for the Track Championships
- 100 USD for each Senior skater entered for the Road Championships
- 50 USD for each Junior skater entered for the Track Championships
- 50 USD for each Junior skater entered for the Road Championships

SPEED JUDGES EXAMINATION SESSION/SPEED SECRETARY JUDGES EXAMINATION SESSION

During the World Championships, it will be organized an Examination Session for those national judges who wish to access an international level.

According to the Technical Commission Regulations:

- World Skate organizes the examination of the Jury with the support of the Technical commission.
- Each candidate must have officiated at least for two (2) years at the maximum category in his/her country. Such candidates must speak fluent english.

A Technical commission member and an experienced International Judge will examine proposed candidates as follows:

- Two (2) hours of a written test about the knowledge of the Inline Speed Technical regulation.
- Oral test of twenty (20) minutes about the knowledge of the Inline Speed Skating discipline. The capacity to speak a fluent English language will be evaluated as well.
- Candidates who succeed in the World Skate two (2) tests will be observed and evaluated in their capacity as a judge in the different tasks of the Jury.

Candidates who pass such exams will be registered as International Judges and can be conveyed for international competitions.

Candidates who succeed this examination must attend the Judges Academy Seminar courses that will follow, in order to validate their international category as per the TC Rulebook articles 17 & 26.

The fee to pay for the inscription at the International Judge examination is **100 USD**.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager and/or Delegate.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2021 and 2022 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the [WADA ADEL platform](#) and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the [WADA ADEL platform](#) is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.

VISA

- *Should you require a VISA, please fill out Annex 1 with all the necessary information and email it to internazionale@fisar.it and operations@worldskate.org. A protocol number will be issued to you by the Italian National Olympic Committee (CONI), which you will need to provide to your local consulate or embassy when requesting your VISA so that the process can be expedited.*

- *Should you NOT require a VISA, and if you are in need of a generic invitation letter, please complete Annex 1 with all the necessary information and send it to Miss. Francesca Segala: account@movi2023.org An invitation letter will be sent to you by the Local Organizing Committee.*

Please note that invitation letters will be issued only after completing the registration process on the World Infinity Platform. No exceptions will be made.


