CATEGORIES

The categories allowed to participate in the Artistic World Cup are as follows:

- Cadet (Men/Women)
- 4 competition figures of one group drawn from the World Skate Figure Groups 1-4
 - Youth (Men/Women)
- 4 competition figures of one group drawn from the World Skate Figure Groups 1-4
 - Junior (Men/Women)
- 3 competition figures of one group drawn from the World Skate Figure Groups 1-4
 - Senior (Men/Women)
- 3 competition figures of one group drawn from the World Skate Figure Groups 1-4



ENTRY RULES

No more than three (3) skaters for each category from each National Federation are allowed.

Entry Fees: USD 80 per skater/per entry.

REGISTRATION DATES & MODALITY

The registration process will be carried out through the World Skate Infinity platform.

World Skate Infinity is available on <u>desktop</u> (browser) and App Version on <u>Play Store</u> (Android) and App Store (iOS).

Single Users (Athletes and National Team Officials) must <u>individually sign up</u> in the App or desktop version and create a profile (if they have not done so already) with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents: passport copy, profile picture (headshot), Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate.

Any single user who fails to complete the above-mentioned steps will not be eligible for event registration.

Single users are Athletes, Presidents, Secretaries-General, Coaches, Doctors and any other National Federation Member who will participate in this or in the forthcoming events representing their Federation of belonging and must sign up individually and on their own in the system, complete the procedure and be approved by their NF of belonging.

Once Athletes and National Team Officials have completed their profile on Infinity, they will be eligible to be <u>registered for the event by their National Federation of belonging</u>.

Payments will be processed through Infinity by credit card or bank transfer.

DISTANCES

The closest airport to Freiburg is Basel, Switzerland (50 km), Strasbourg, France (64 km), Zurich, Switzerland (81 km), Stuttgart (126 km) or Frankfurt am Main International (260 km). Germany has a good train system available for transport from the airports to Freiburg.

ACCOMMODATION

We request all participants to be aware of the travel regulations before planning their travel to the event. Especially make sure that you obtain the necessary Visa before entering the European Union / Germany.
