COUNTRY QUOTA

The maximum skaters registrations per National Team for each category **Track and Road**:

Senior men: 8 skaters

Senior women: 8 skaters

Junior men: 8 skaters

Junior women: 8 skaters

Please note that:

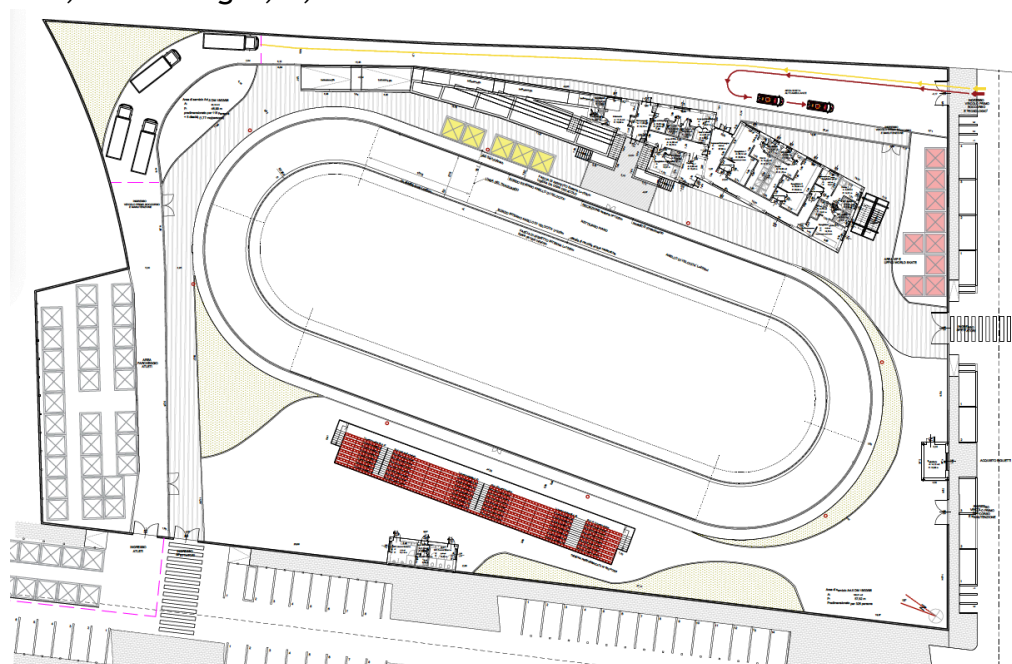
- Only 2 skaters per National Team may take part in each race.
- Either 3 or 4 skaters per National Team may be registered in the Relay Race.

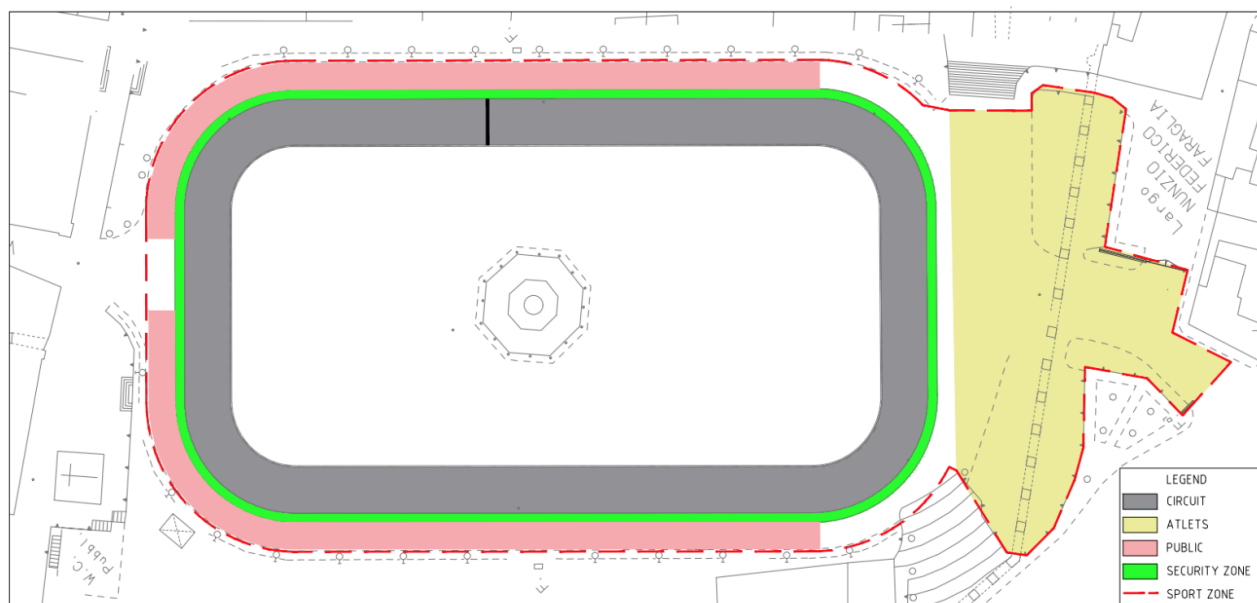


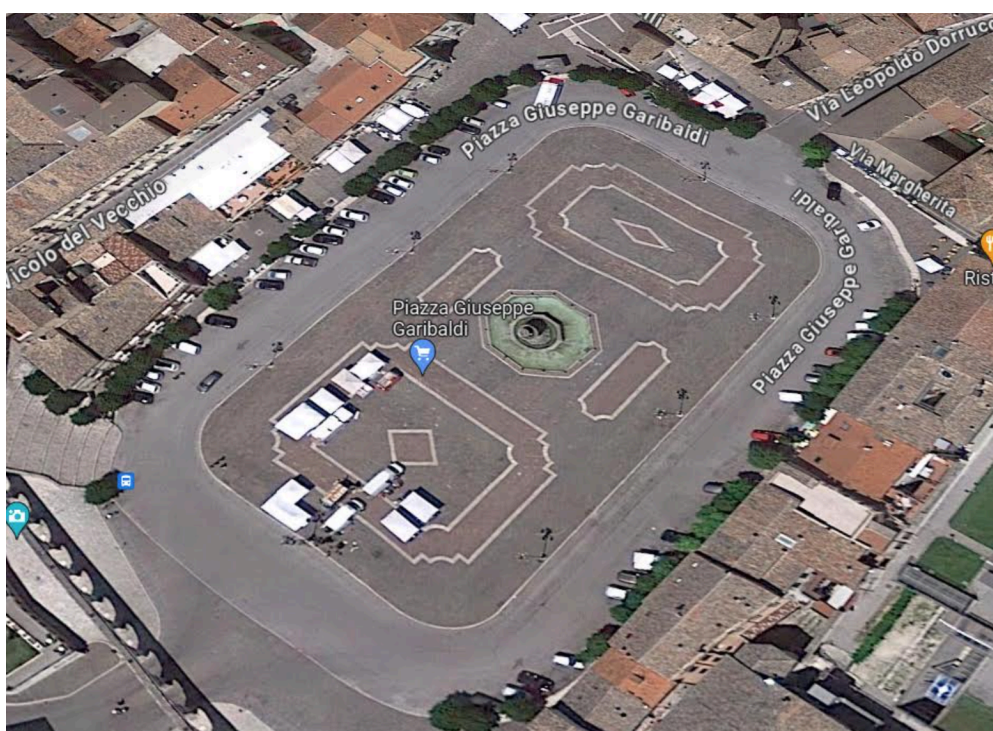

QUALIFYING COMPETITION FOR THE WORLD GAMES CHENGDU 2025

As per the Speed Rulebook, the 2024 Speed World Championships is the qualifying competition for 2025 TWG Chengdu. Sixty (60) spots are to be defined for the Senior category as follows:

- Thirty (30) Senior Women
- Thirty (30) Senior Men

The Technical Commission will prepare a dedicated ranking following the article 59:

- a. Two (2) women and two (2) men from the Organizing Federation are directly qualified.
- b. No more than two (2) women and two (2) men for the same nation can be qualified.
- c. From a same nation, the maximum number of qualified skaters is:
 - one (1) woman in Short Distance races,
 - one (1) man in Short Distance races,
 - one (1) woman in Long Distance races,
 - one (1) man in Long Distance races.
- d. A total of fifteen (15) Women skaters and fifteen (15) Men skaters will qualify from the Short Distance races (including those qualified from the Organizing Federation mentioned in point “a”).
- e. A total of fifteen (15) Women skaters and fifteen (15) Men skaters will qualify from the Long Distance races (including those qualified from the Organizing Federation mentioned in point “a”).
- f. The corresponding National Federations are obliged to participate at the World Games with qualified skaters or other skaters of the same level and the same speciality (Short or Long Distance) if qualified skaters are not available.

Procedure:

- a. The overall ranking per type of race is done based on the sum of the three (3) best results of each skater per type of race.
- b. The winner of each race gets forty (40) points, the second thirty-nine (39), and so on.

REGISTRATION DATES & MODALITY

The registration process will be carried out through the World Skate Infinity platform.

World Skate Infinity is available on [desktop](#) (browser) and App Version on [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and [App Store \(iOS\)](#).

Single Users must individually sign up in the App or desktop version and create a profile (if they have not done so already) with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents:

- profile picture (headshot)
- passport picture and details
- Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate

Any single user who fails to complete the above-mentioned steps will not be eligible for event registration.

Single users are Athletes, Presidents, Secretaries-General, Coaches, Doctors and any other National Federation Member who will participate in this or in the forthcoming events representing their Federation of belonging and must sign up individually and on their own in the system, complete the procedure and be approved by their NF of belonging.

Once Athletes and National Team Officials have completed their profile on Infinity, they will be eligible to be registered for the event by their National Federation of belonging.

Payments will be processed through Infinity by credit/debit card or bank transfer.

Application for Neutral Athletes:

Russian and Belarusian athletes can participate only as “Neutral athletes” following the [“Eligibility Criteria for the participation of Russian and Belarusian Athletes”](#).

ENTRY FEES

Each participating country will pay the following entry fees:

- 400 USD for each country participating at the Senior Championship
- 100 USD for each Senior skater entered for the Track Championship
- 100 USD for each Senior skater entered for the Road Championship
- 50 USD for each Junior skater entered for the Track Championship
- 50 USD for each Junior skater entered for the Road Championship

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the WADA Code, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), incorporating the requirements of the Technical Document for Sport Specific Analysis (TDSSA), and following the instruction of the World Skate Anti-doping Manager/Delegate.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course

Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2022, 2023 and 2024 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the [WADA ADEL platform](#) and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the [WADA ADEL platform](#) is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.

JUDGES EXAMINATION SESSION

There will be an Examination Session for those national judges who wish to access the International Judge category: International Judge or International Secretary Judge.
