SPEED SKATING

The Organization will provide the athletes with free accommodation, catering and local transport.

REGISTRATION DATES AND MODALITY

Each qualified National Federation must submit their athletes' name from January 27th and not later than March 30th 2025, to sportsdepartment@worldskate.org

Among others, this submission shall include emergency contact name (and phone number), departure city and airport code, if a visa is required, dietary restrictions if any.

INSURANCE

All participants, including athletes and officials representing your federation, must possess a valid private health and repatriation insurance in accordance with the Rules of The World Games.

This insurance must mandatorily cover the following:

- Accidental medical treatment, sudden illness, and hospitalization allowance.
- Repatriation costs in emergencies requiring a return to your place of departure.

Participants are required to purchase the adequate insurance prior to their departure and provide a valid insurance certificate upon arrival in Chengdu as part of the accreditation process.

Important:

Any participant failing to present their insurance certificate or not meeting the minimum required coverage will not be allowed to participate in The World Games 2025.

World Skate, the Chengdu ExCo and IWGA will not be held liable for any risks, denial, costs or loss arising from a lack of adequate insurance.

We kindly request all National Federations to ensure compliance with these requirements and communicate this information to your athletes and officials at the earliest opportunity.

ANTIDOPING

The World Anti-doping Code (WADA Code) and all applicable International Standards and



Guidelines will be strictly implemented during TWG 2025 Chengdu to ensure fair sportsmanship and clean sport.

The doping control rules provided by the IWGA are expected to be released in February 2025. Once issued, they will be shared through another bulletin.
