

COUNTRY QUOTA

Each National Federation can register the following maximum number of skaters for each discipline:

Discipline	Men	Women
Speed	6 Senior, 6 Junior	6 Senior, 6 Junior
Classic	6 Senior, 6 Junior	6 Senior, 6 Junior
Pair	3 Pairs (Open, any pair)	
Battle	6 Senior, 6 Junior	6 Senior, 6 Junior
Slides	6	6
Free Jump	6	6

Maximum 32 men skaters and 32 women skaters are allowed for every National Team. The categories allowed to compete are as follows:

- **Senior:** Born on or before December 31st, 2006;
- Junior: Born on or after January 1st, 2007 and on or before December 31st, 2015

Please note that the organization will check all the athletes' passports at the moment of registration in order to validate the category of each skater.

REGISTRATION DATES AND MODALITY

The registration process will be carried out through the World Skate Infinity platform.

World Skate Infinity is available on <u>desktop</u> (browser) and App Version on <u>Play Store</u> (Android) and <u>App Store</u> (iOS).

Single Users (Athletes and National Team Officials) must <u>individually sign up</u> in the App or desktop version and create a profile (if they have not done so already) with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents: passport copy, profile



picture (headshot), Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate.

Any single user who fails to complete the above-mentioned steps will not be eligible for event registration.

Single users are Athletes, Presidents, Secretaries-General, Coaches, Doctors and any other National Federation Member who will participate in this or in the forthcoming events representing their Federation of belonging and must sign up individually and on their own in the system, complete the procedure and be approved by their NF of belonging.

Once Athletes and National Team Officials have completed their profile on Infinity, they will be eligible to be <u>registered</u> for the event by their National Federation of belonging.

Payments will be processed through Infinity by credit card or bank transfer.

October 7th - November 19th, 2025

ENTRY FEES

Each participating country will pay the following entry fees:

- 1. \$50 USD for each skater who registered for individual discipline.
- 2. \$100 USD for each pair in Pair Slalom.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the WADA Code, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), incorporating the requirements of the Technical Document for Sport Specific Analysis (TDSSA), and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager and/or Delegate.



During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping organizations and/or World Skate during 2023, 2024 and 2025 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the <u>WADA ADEL</u> <u>platform</u> and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the WADA ADEL platform is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.

VISA

It is recommended to contact the Embassy/Consultant in your country or region and apply for a visa ahead of time.
