ROLLER SPEED SKATING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS 2018

According to World Skate Statutes, Rules for the World Championships Art. 4, we have pleasure to inform you that the 2018 World Senior and Youth Roller Speed Skating Championships on track and on road are scheduled as above mentioned.

The registration will be available through the official online platform. The World Skate will inform you as soon as the platform will be open for the registration.

The expenses of travel, board and lodging will be up to each attending team,

ENTRY FEES

Each participating country will pay the following entry fees:

- 400 USD for each country participating at the Senior Championships
- 100 USD for each senior skater entered for the Track Championships
- 100 USD for each senior skater entered for the Road Championships
- 50 USD for each youth skater entered for the Road Championships
- 50 USD for each youth skater entered for the Track Championships

Fees must be paid without additional bank expenses (free of charge) to World Skate

PARTICIPATION AT THE SENIOR WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

A total of eight male and eight female skaters may be registered in the Championships for each attending country. No more than two male and two female skaters can participate in calendar events.

PARTICIPATION AT THE JUNIOR WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

A total of eight male and eight female skaters may be registered in the Championships for each attending country. No more than two male and two female skaters can participate in calendar events.

DISTANCES

The race program will be the same for men and women, Youth and Senior categories.

TRACK July 01-03 (Heerde)

- 500 m sprint tournament
- 1.000 m sprint tournament
- 10.000 m points + elimination race
- 15.000 m elimination race (Senior)
- 5000 m elimination race (Junior)
- 3.000 m relays

ROAD July 05-07 (Arnhem)

- 100 m sprint tournament
- 1 lap circuit
- 10.000 m points race
- 20.000 m elimination race

MARATHON July 08 (Arnhem)

Please, take note that to attend the World Junior Championship a skater shall be aged 15,16,17,18 on December 31, 2018. The athletes eligible in 2018 are skaters born in 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003. Skaters allowed to participate by their age shall although enter the Senior or the Junior Championship only. A skater having participated at a World Senior Championship shall not participate to any other World Junior Championship.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

The anti-doping control will be carried out according to World Skate Medical Regulations and WADA Rules.

CONTROL OF FEMALE SEX

In conformity with IOC guidelines, WORLD SKATE is entitled to conduct some tests on specific occasions. This would mean laboratory tests could be done if there is a suspicion.

The WORLD SKATE will send a subsequent circular indicating the website of the Organizing Committee, logistics and program of competitions.
